Camp Buzz Summer Camp 2025 Behavior Contract

All campers and parents must sign and return this contract by email or bring the first day of camp.

Parents must go over this with their children:

- 1. I will show respect to all Camp Buzz instructors and counselors.
- 2. I will follow all camp rules.
- 3. I will help clean-up.
- 4. I will be responsible for my own belongings and NOT take any other campers belongings.
- 5. I will stay with the group. I will ask permission from an adult if I am going to the restroom. I must ALWAYS be escorted with a partner.
- 6. I will respect the camp facility and its equipment. Campers will be responsible for all damage due to negligence or intentional vandalism.

Unacceptable Behaviors:

- 1. Discrimination of another camper/staff member based on race, sexual orientation, religion, age, gender identification, national origin, or handicap
- 2. Physical fighting or violence toward another camper or staff member
- 3. Leaving camp without permission
- 4. Insubordination
- 5. Verbal misconduct toward another child or staff member
- 6. The use of obscene, profane, or vulgar language
- 7. Any action that puts the safety of themselves, fellow campers, or staff at risk
- 8. Secretly recording or photographing any individual at camp
- 9. Bullying behavior intended to intimidate, humiliate, demean, harass, or embarrass campers or staff
- 10. Inappropriate physical contact with other campers and staff
- a. Playing rough (wrestling)
- b. Picking another child up against their consent (unless for medical or safety purposes)

- c. Pulling arms, pinching, hitting
- d. Swinging another child by the arms or legs
- E. Taking something that does not belong to them

Disciplinary Process for Violating Behavior Contract:

1st Time Infraction: WARNING

2nd Time Infraction: Time out or loss of privilege

3rd Time Infraction: Parent Call

4th Time Infraction: Child is Sent Home and no Field Trip
